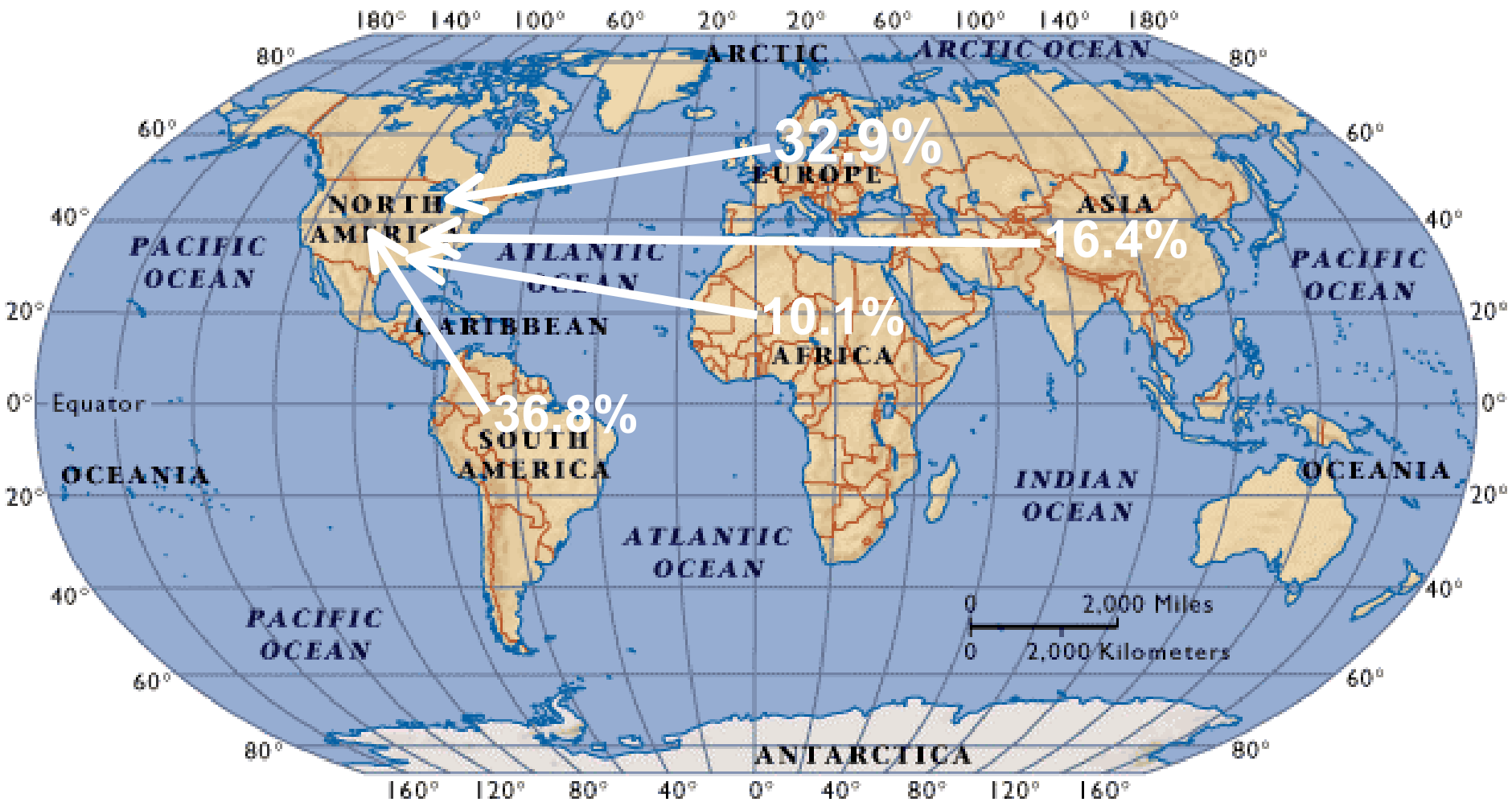

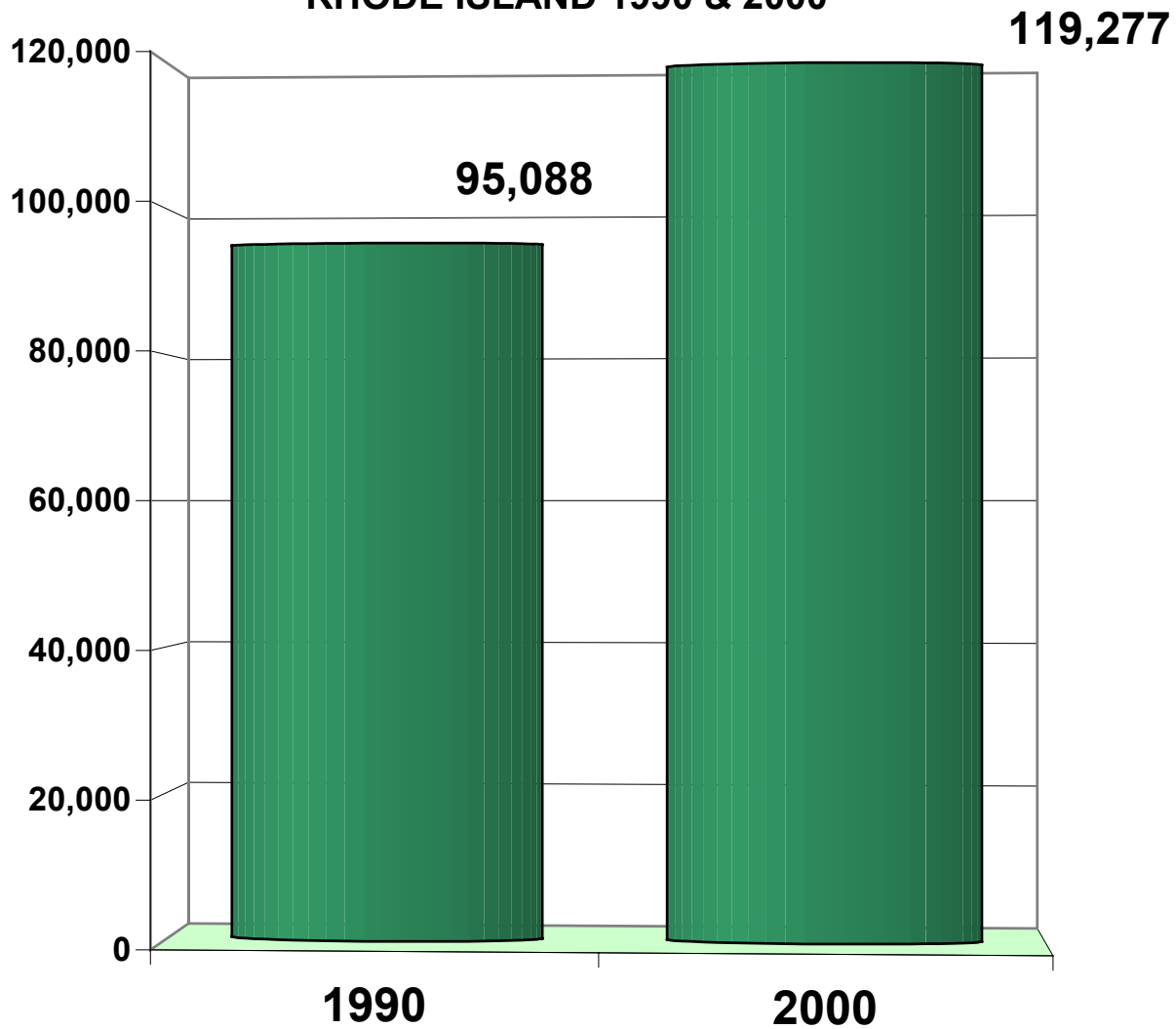

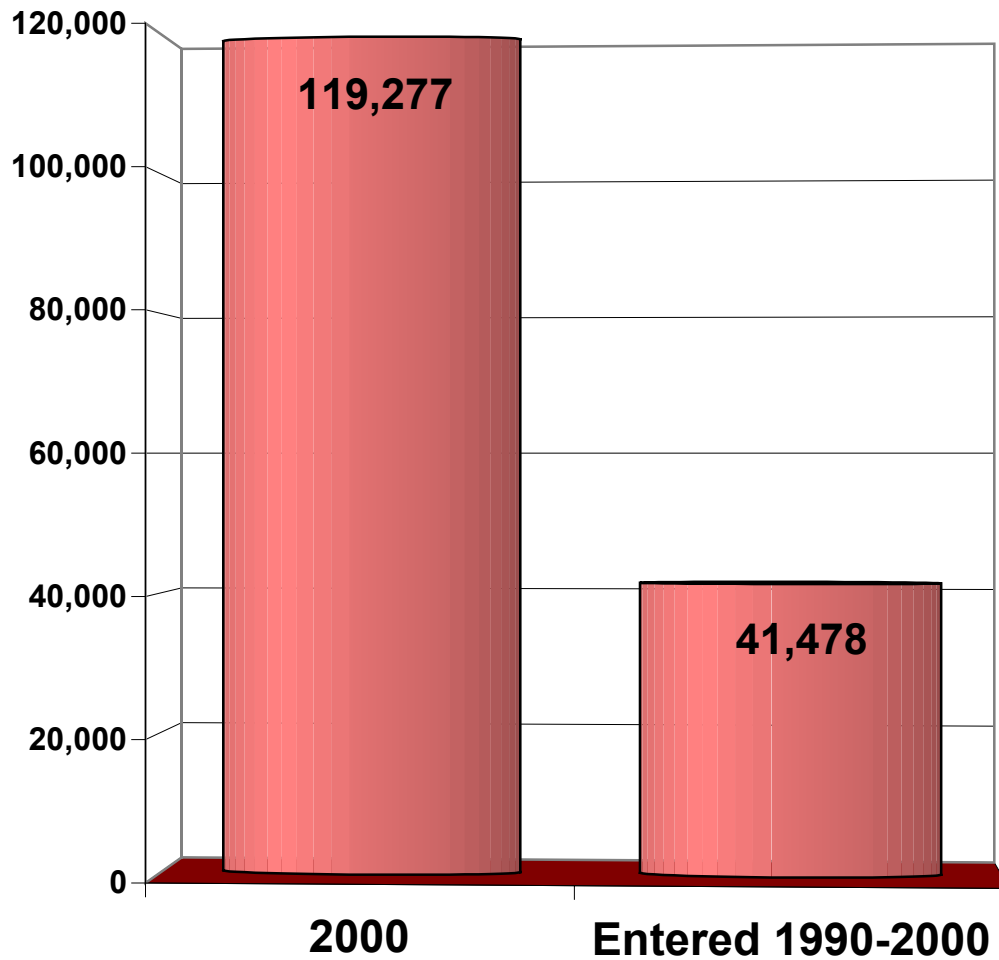
## Percent of Foreign Born Population



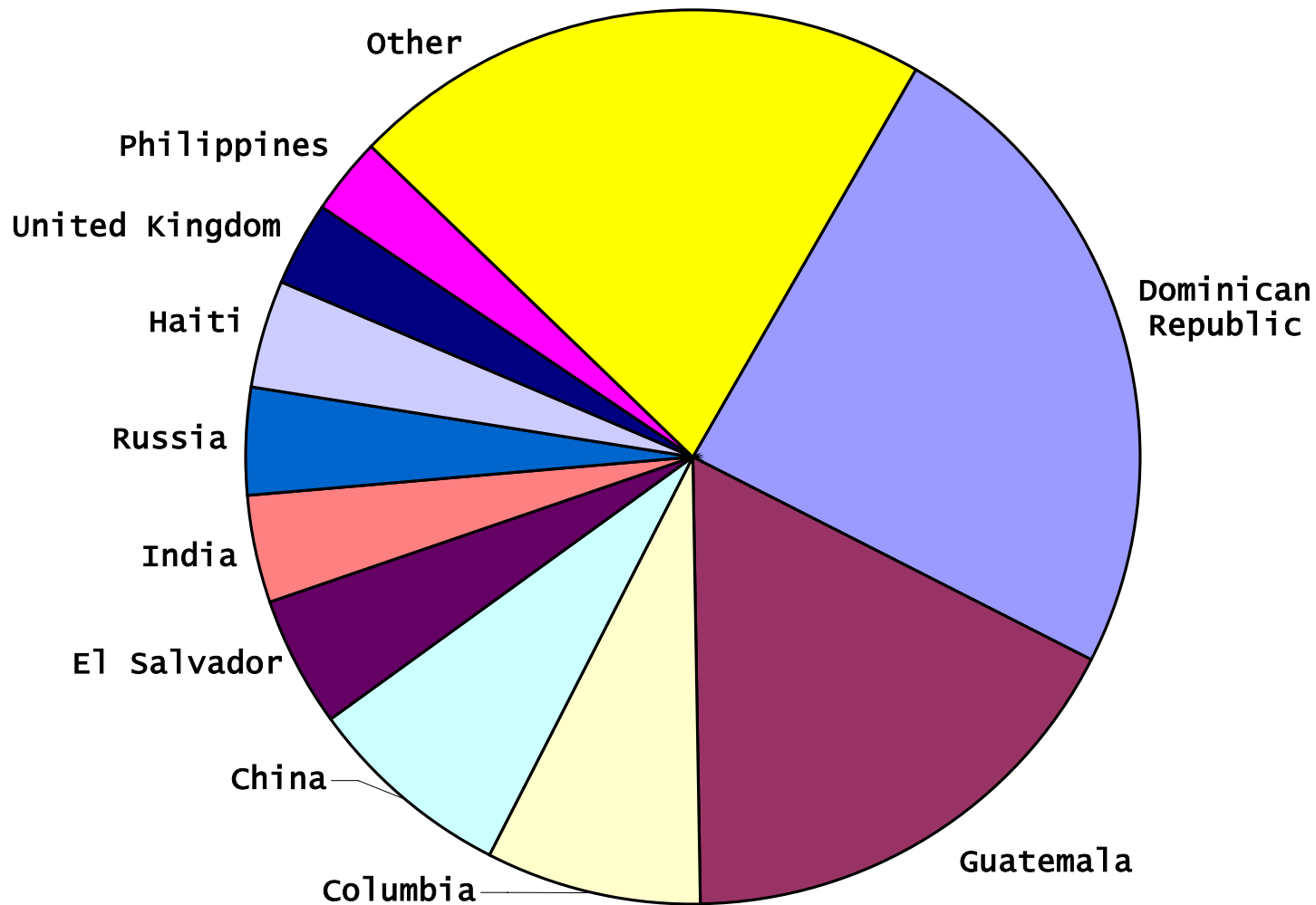
### FOREIGN BORN POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 1990 & 2000

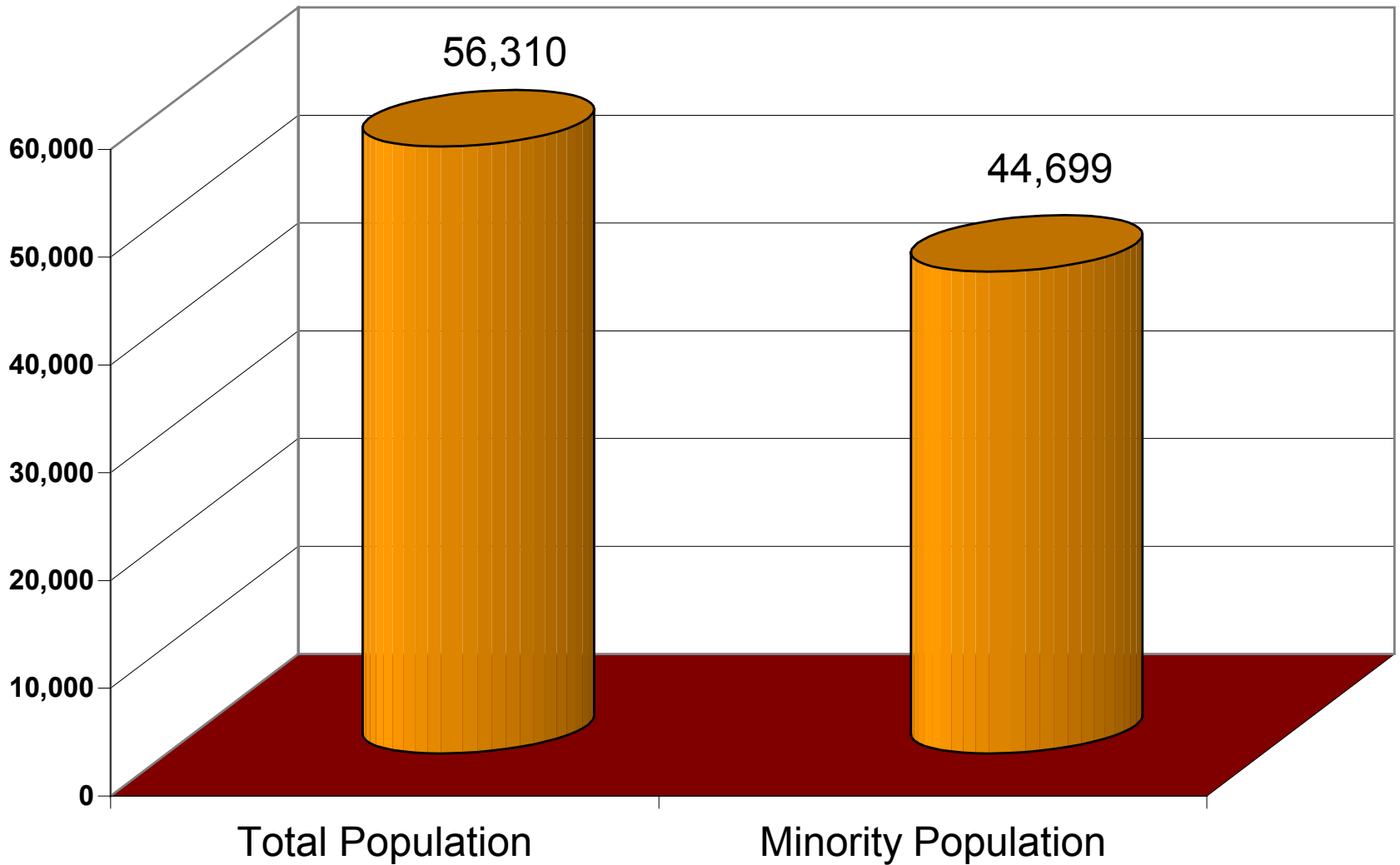

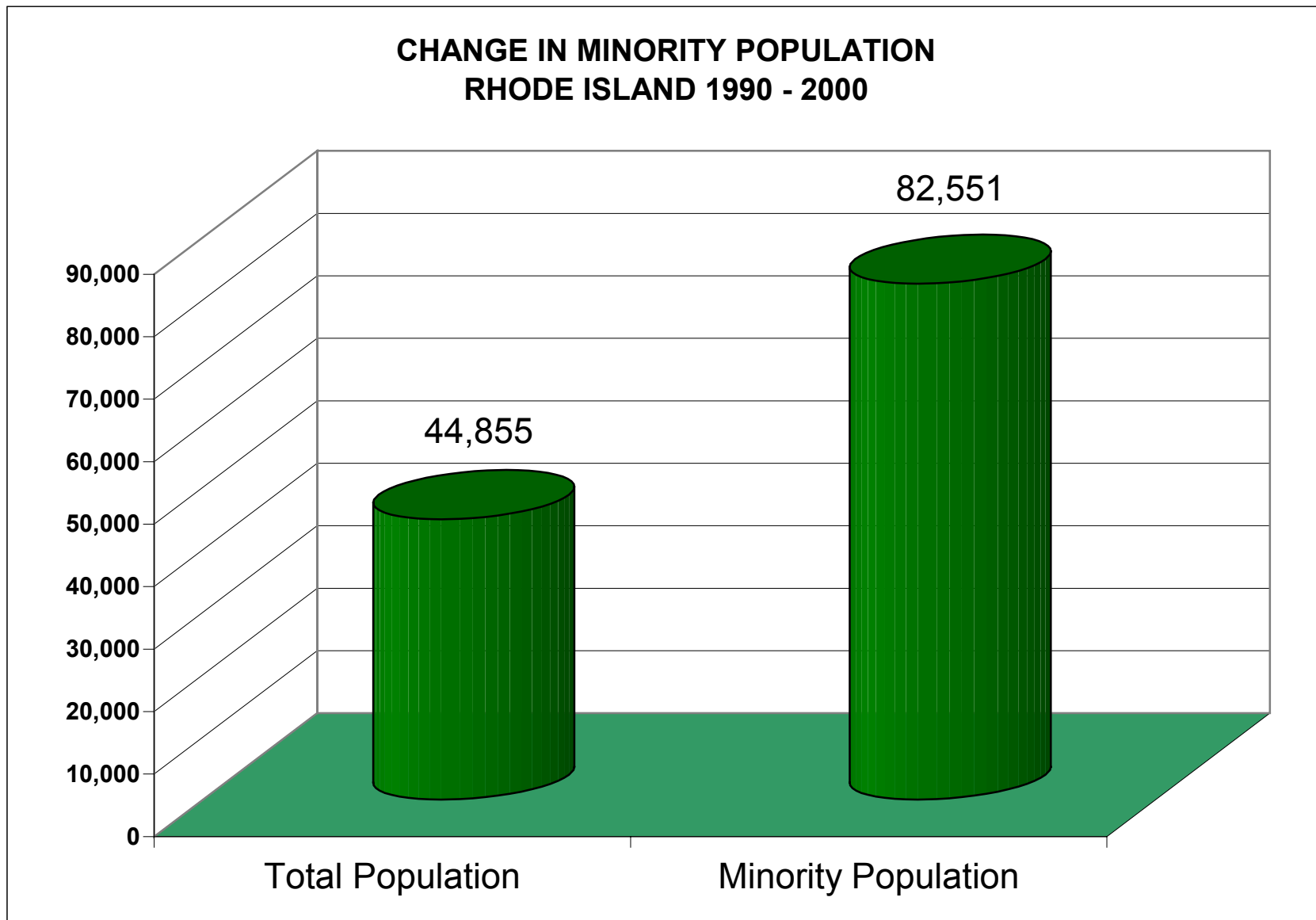

### CHANGE IN MINORITY POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 1980 - 1990



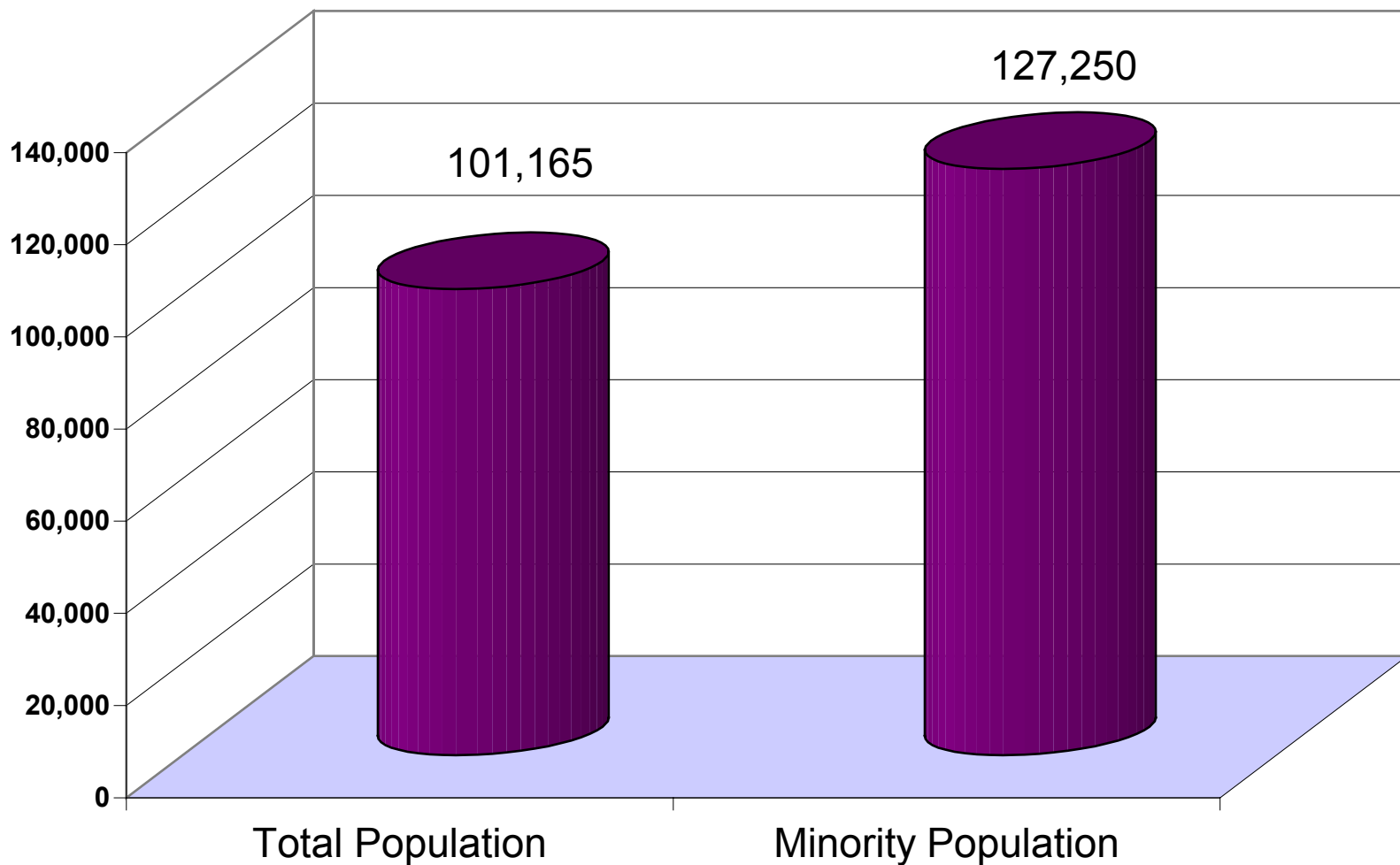

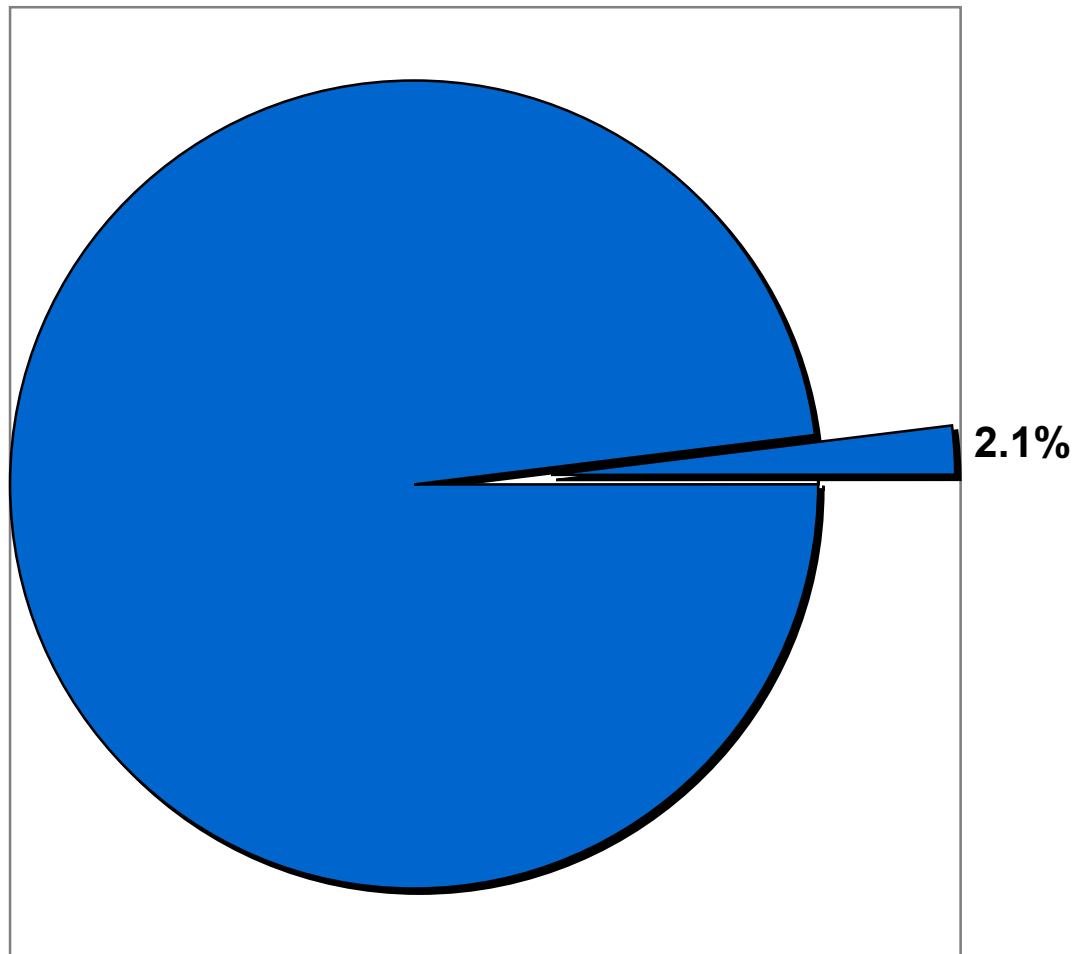

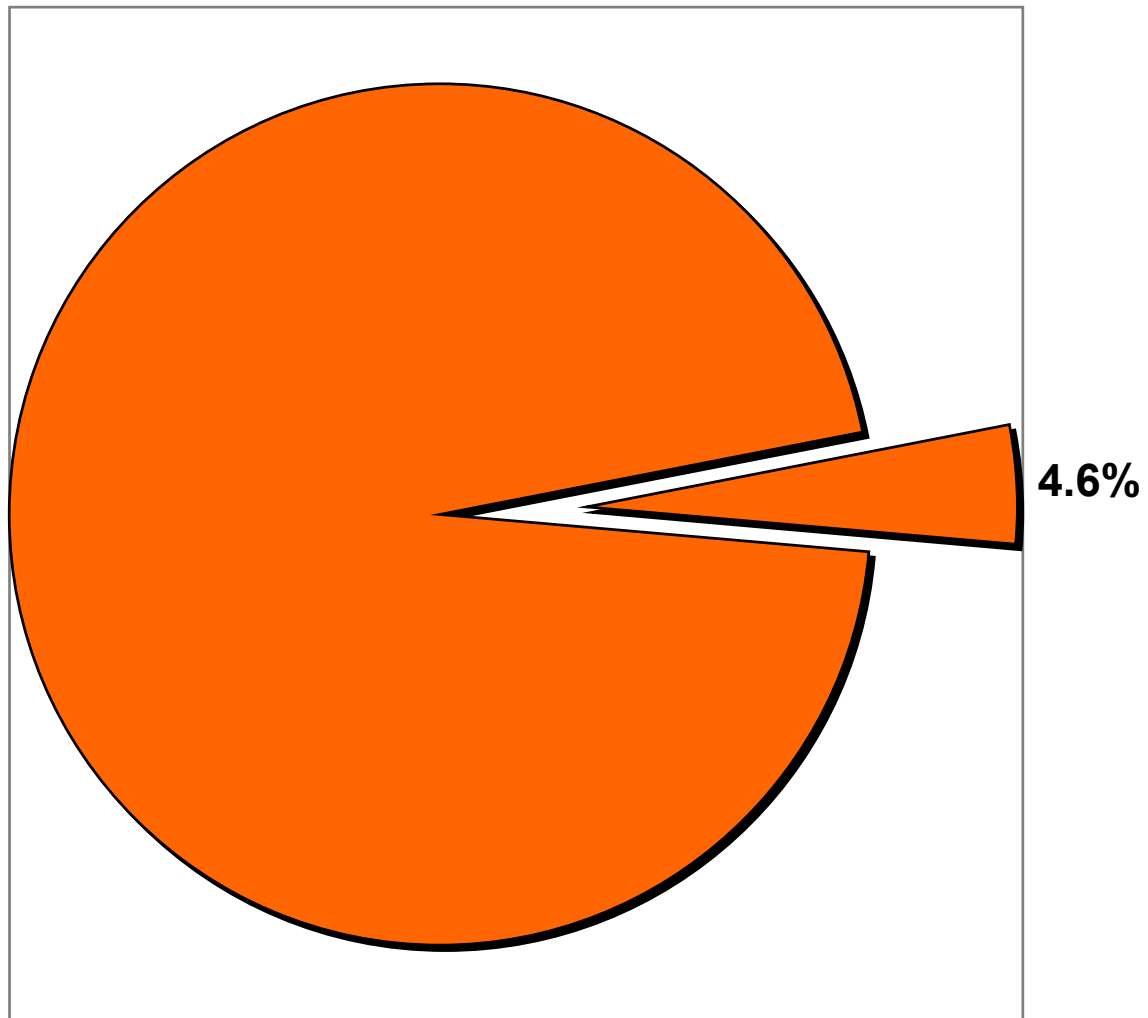
### HISPANIC POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 1980



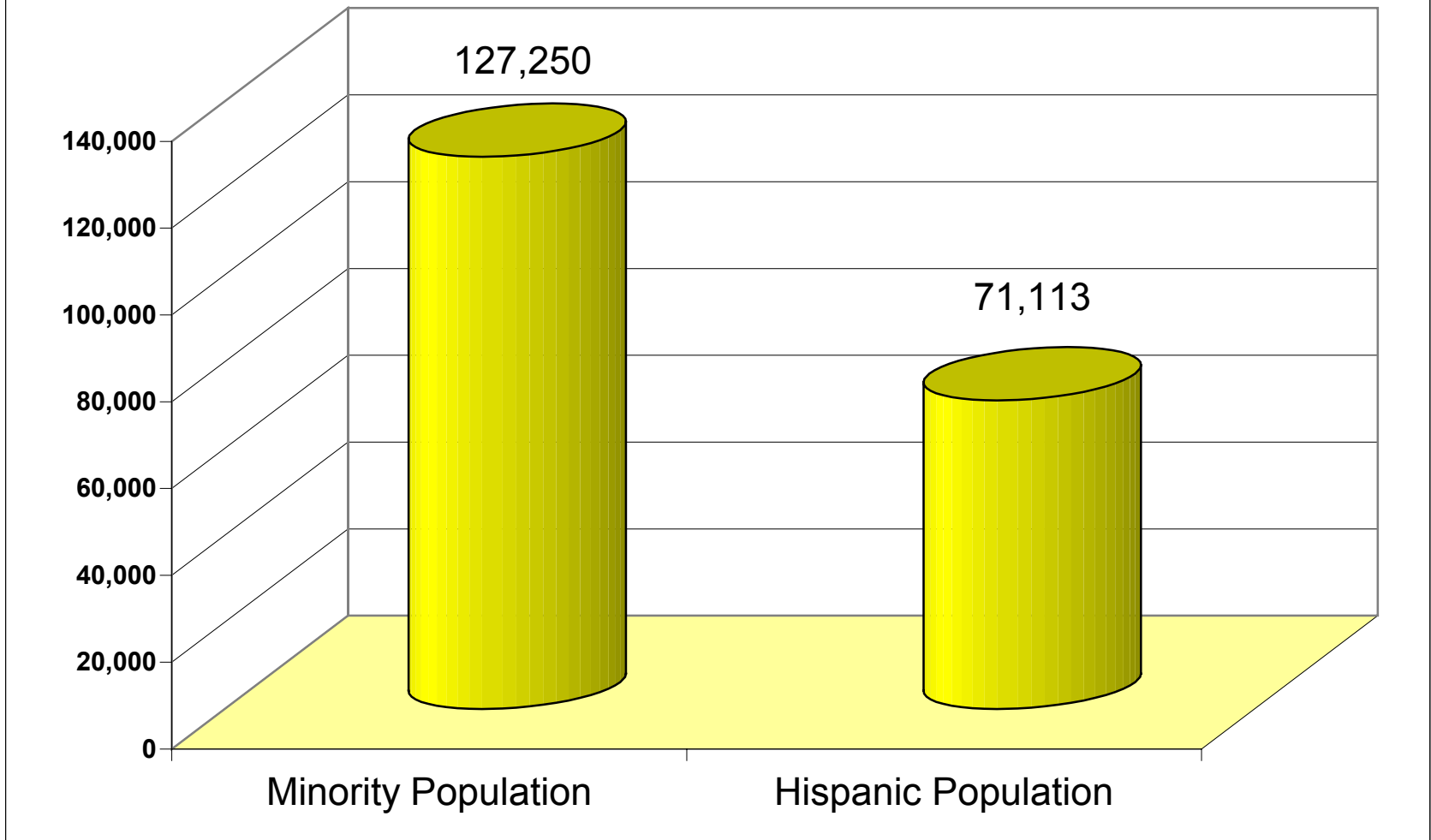

### HISPANIC POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 1990



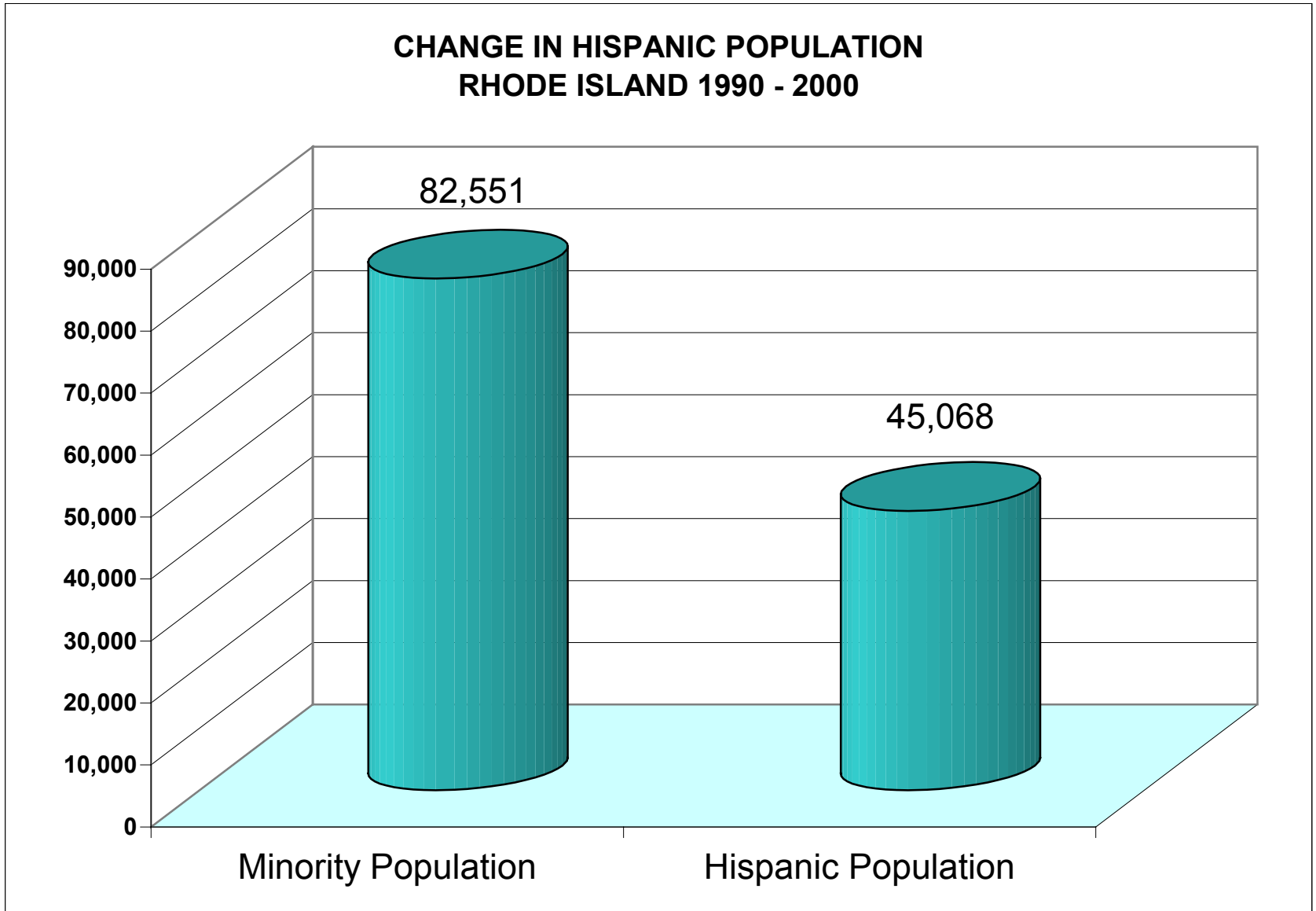
### CHANGE IN HISPANIC POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 1980 - 2000

Change in Hispanic Population 1980-2000 graph

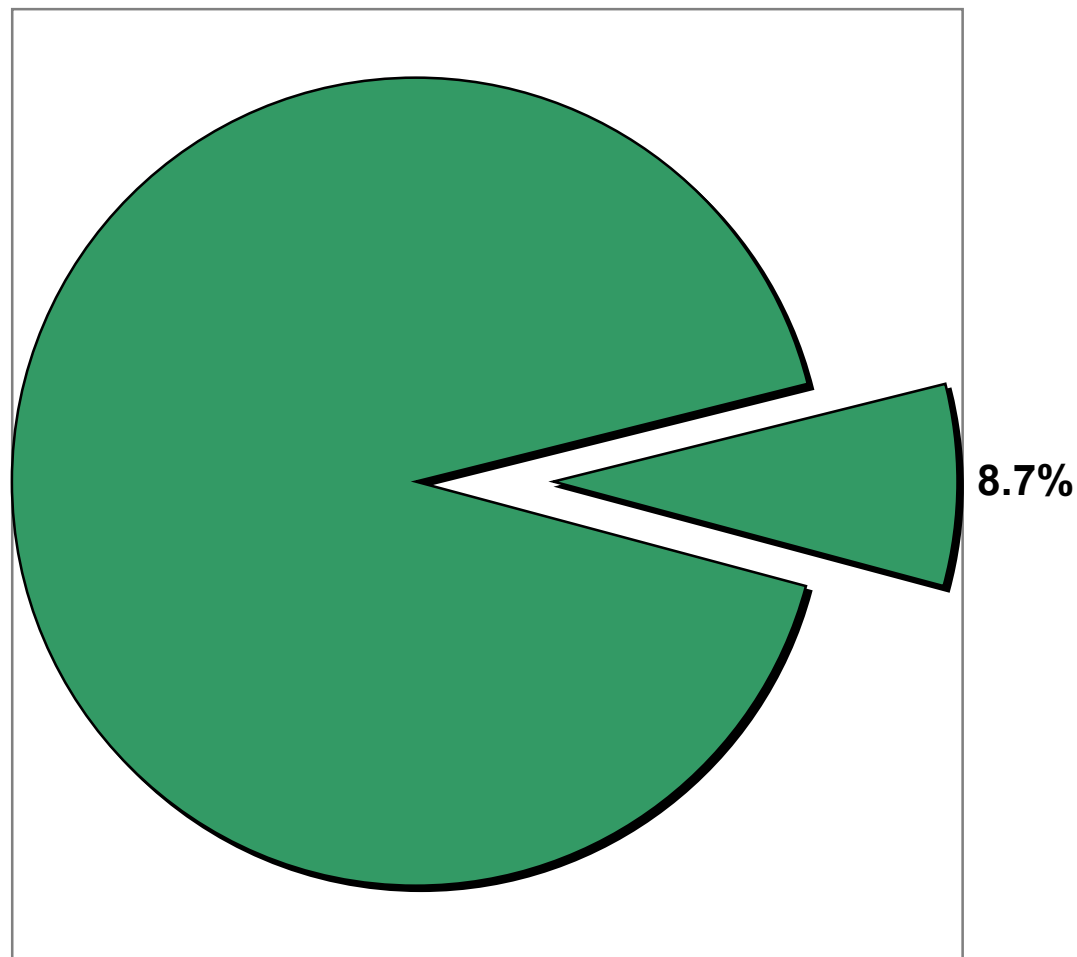

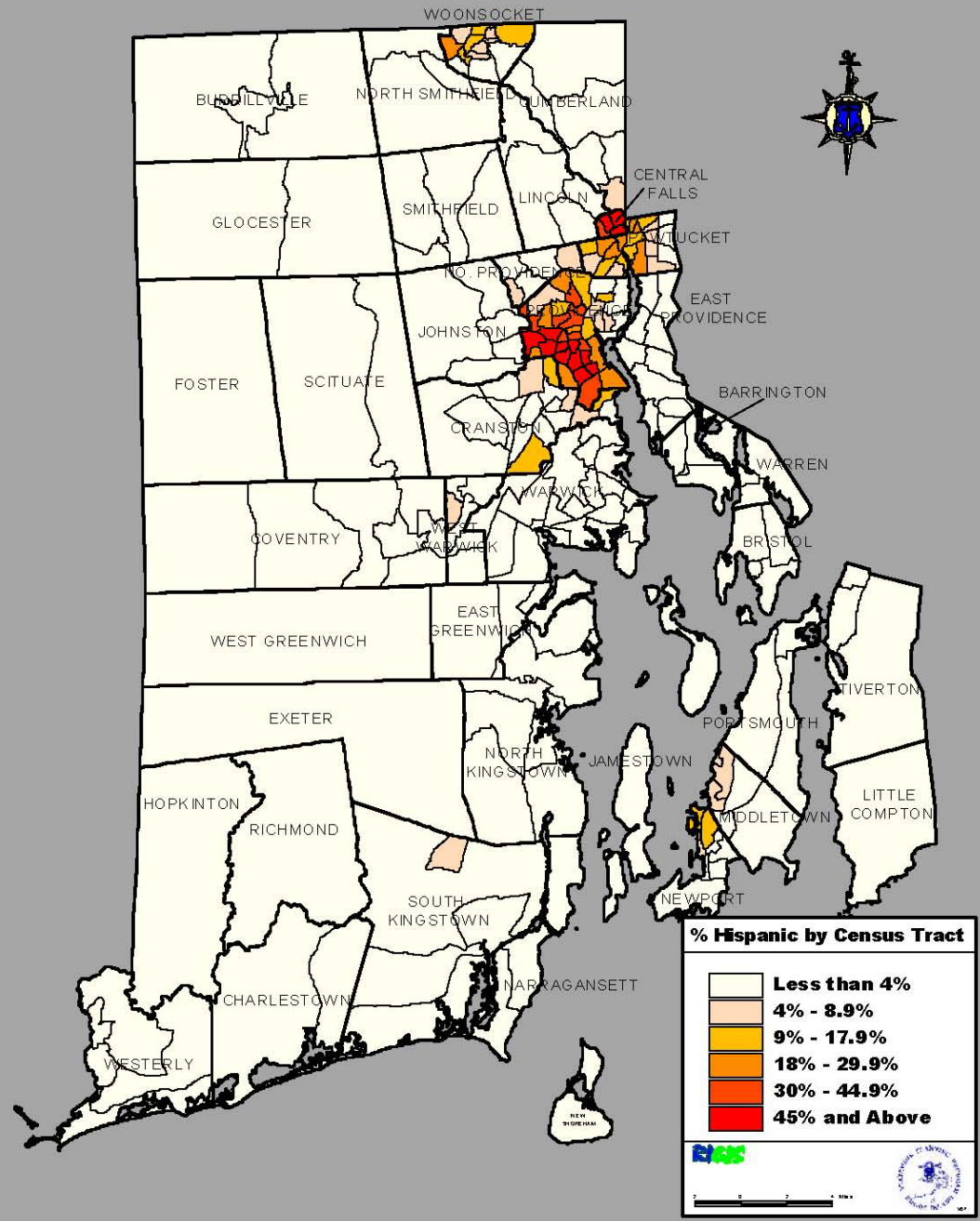

Change in Hispanic Population 1990-2000 graph

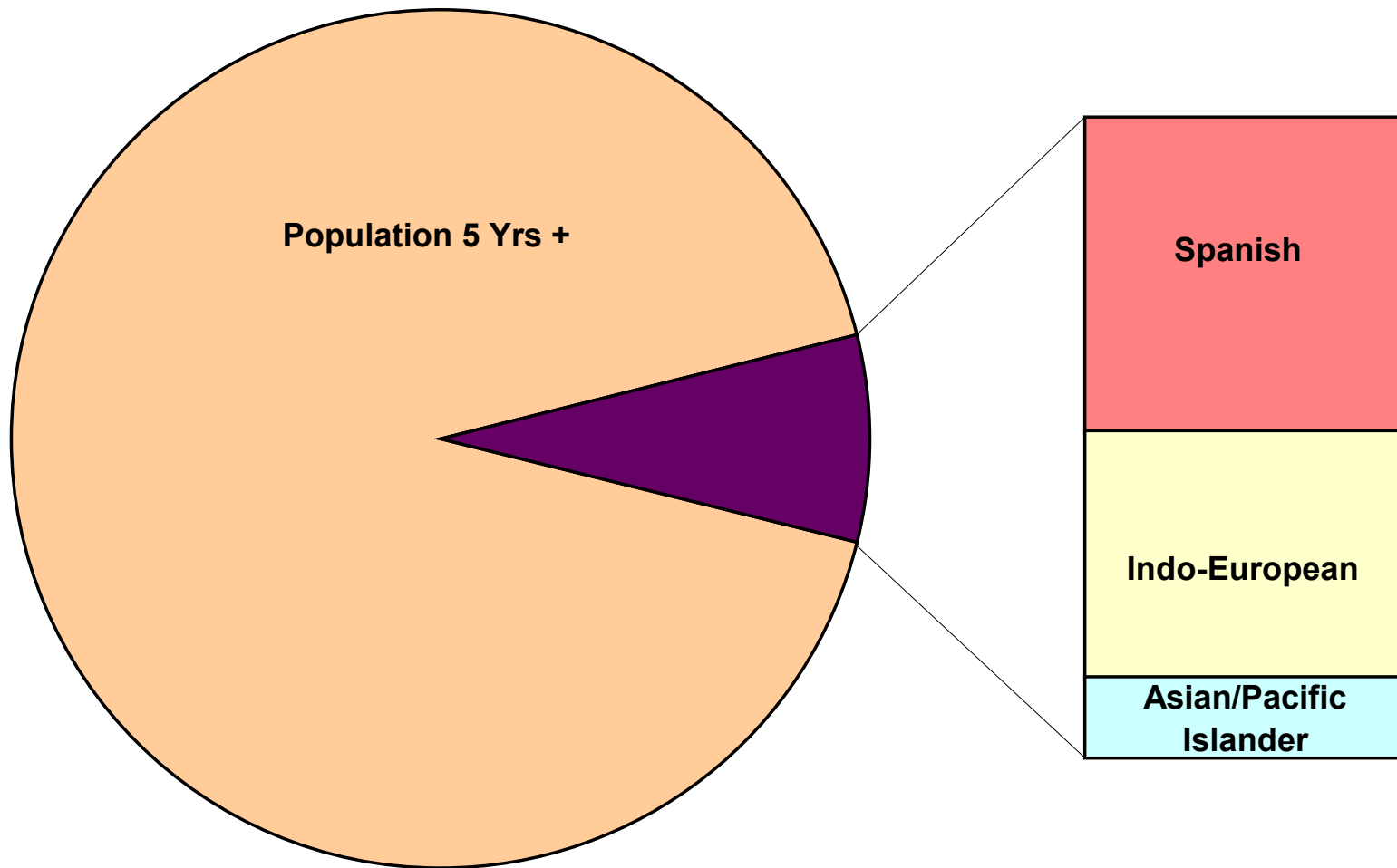
### HISPANIC POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 2000

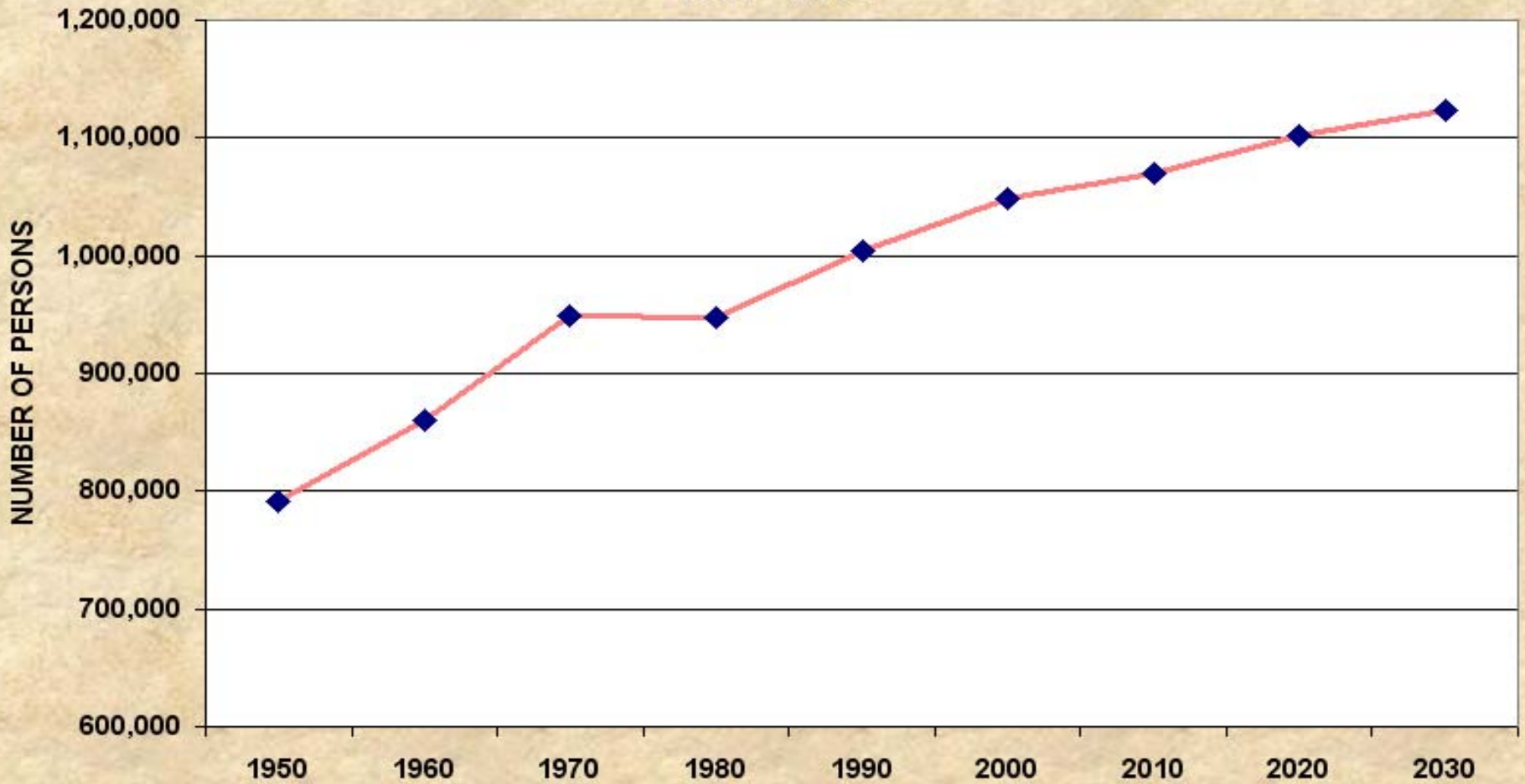

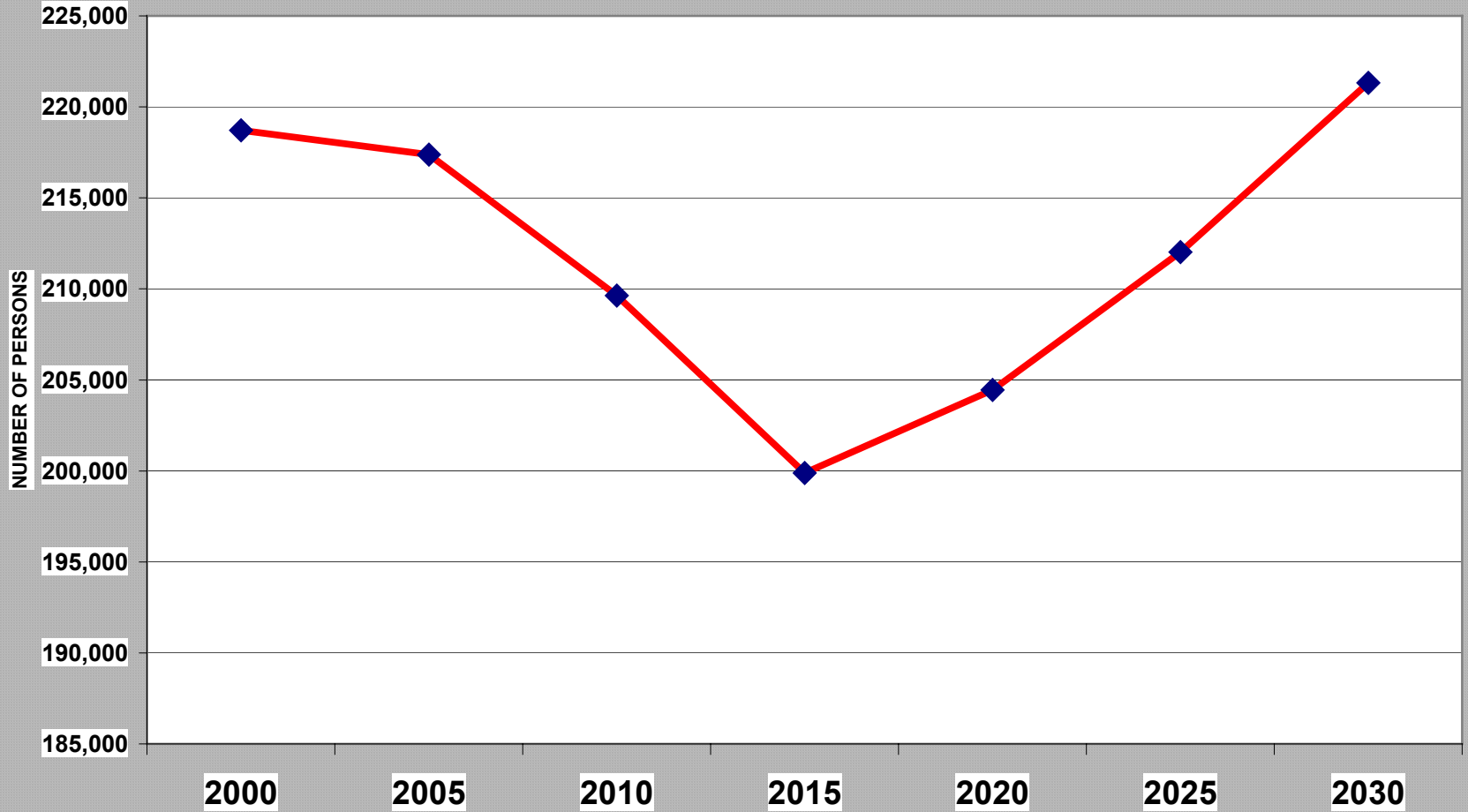

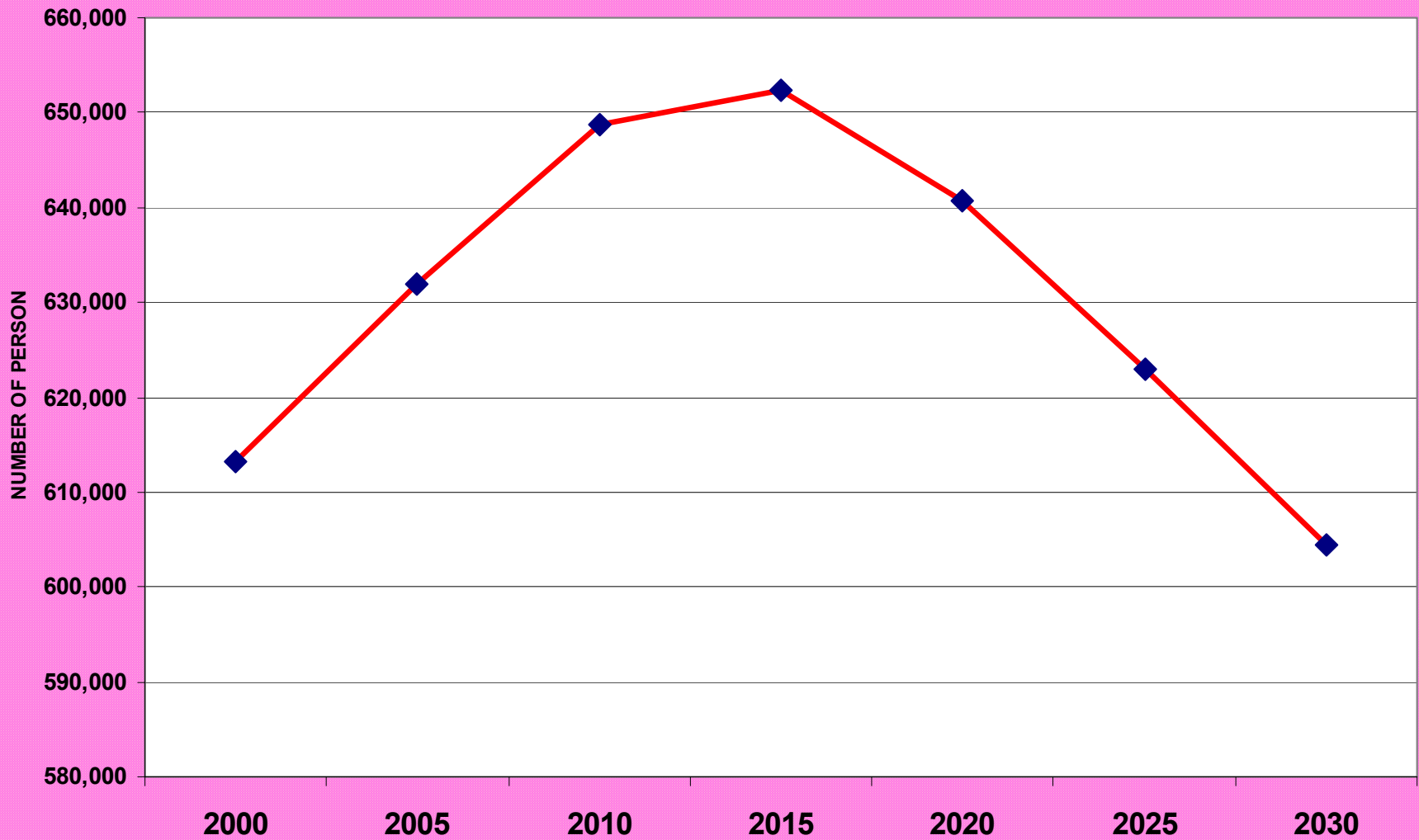
# SCHOOL AGE POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 2000 - 2030

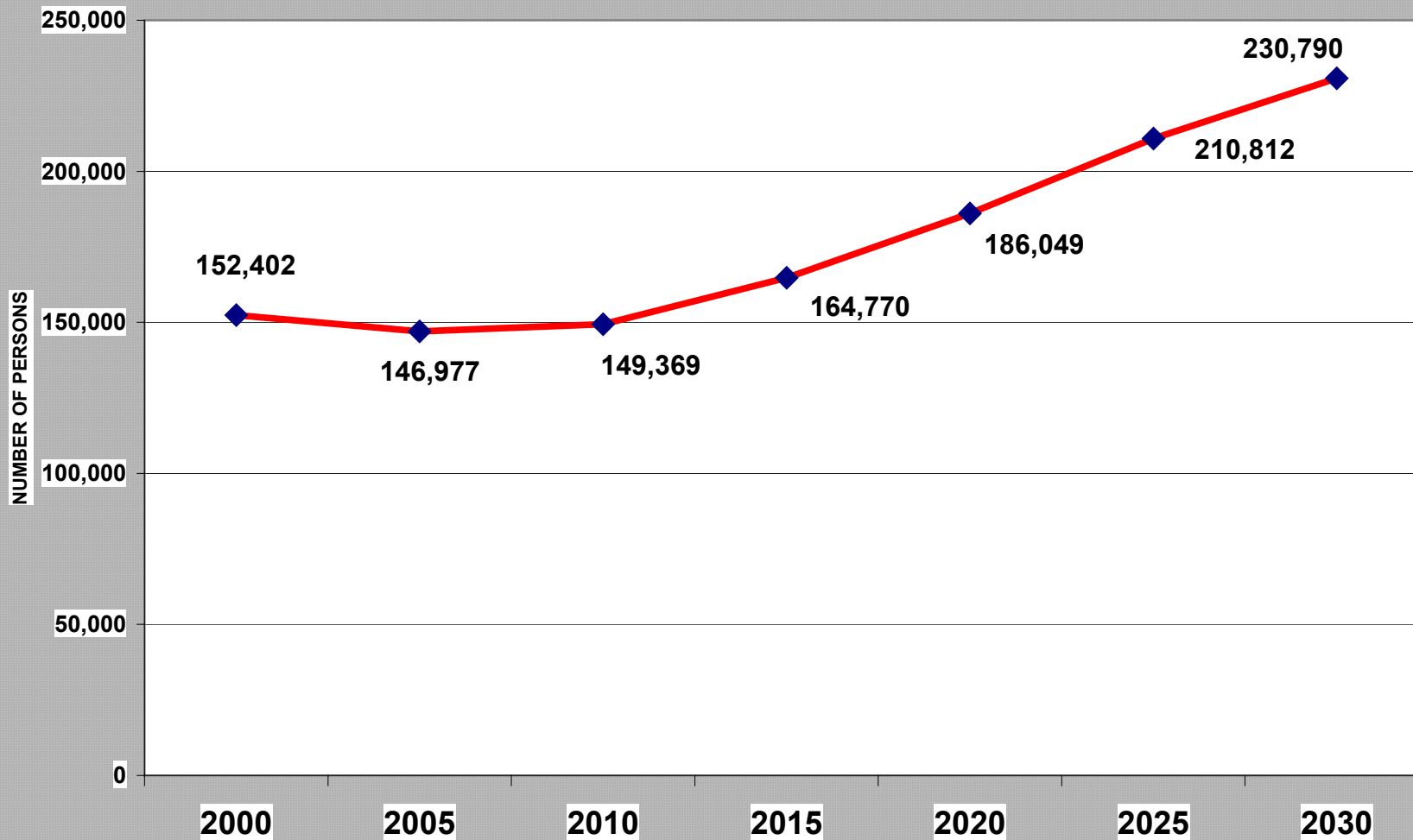
School Age Pop

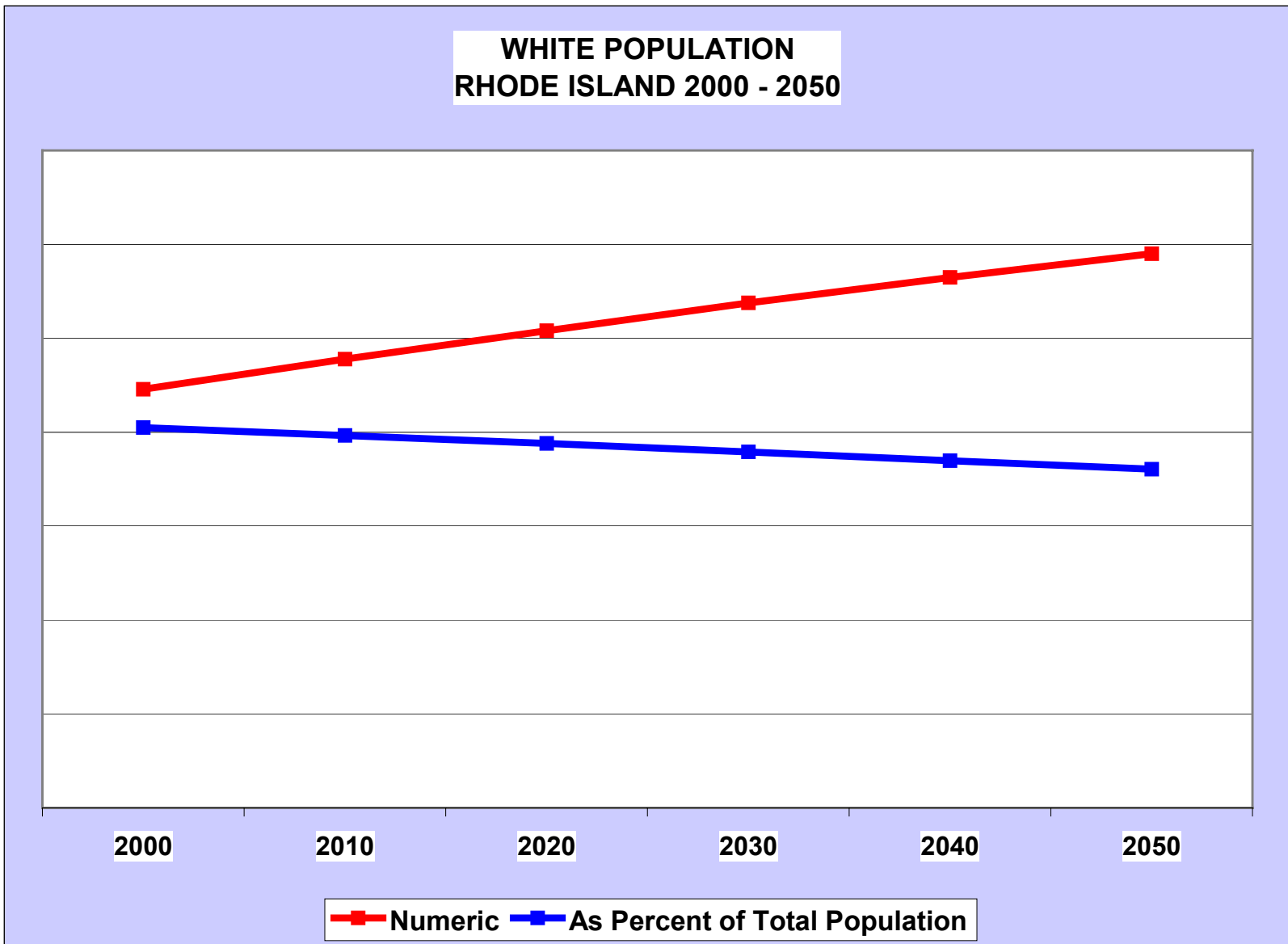
# WORKING AGE POPULATION RHODE ISLAND 2000 - 2030

### ELDERLY POPULATION 65+ RHODE ISLAND 2000 - 2030

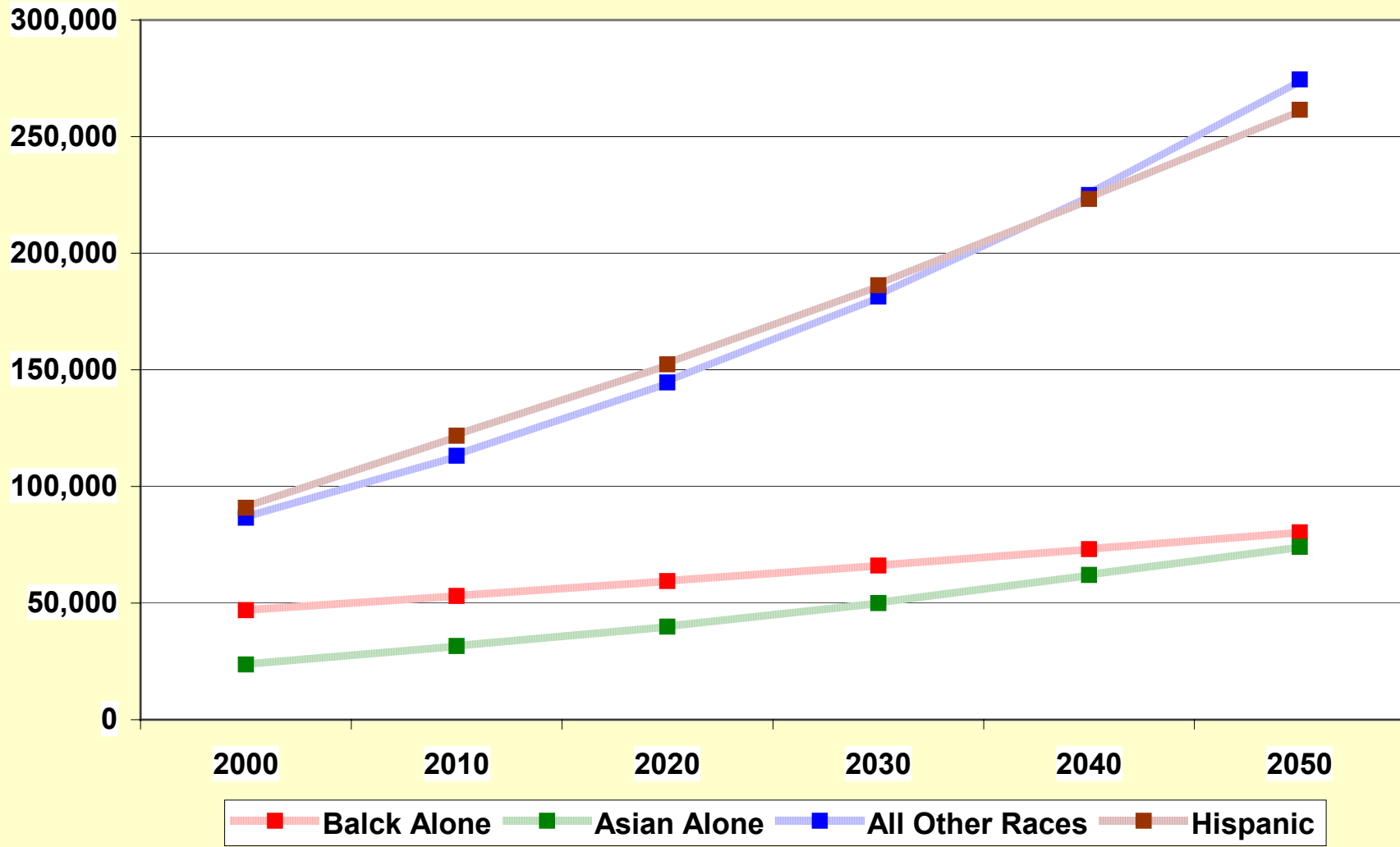

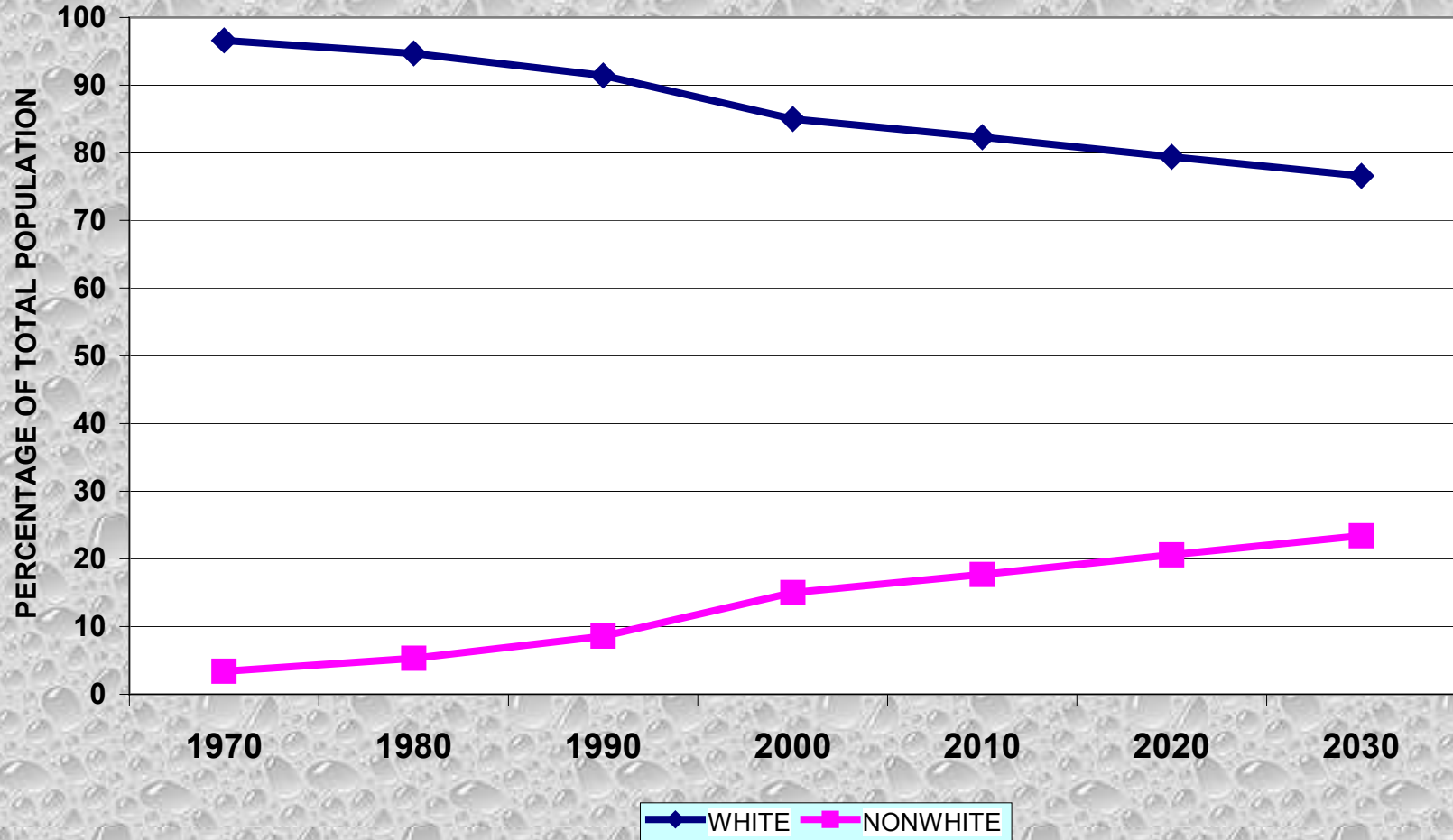
## RACIAL & ETHNIC POPULATION GROWTH RHODE ISLAND 2000 - 2050

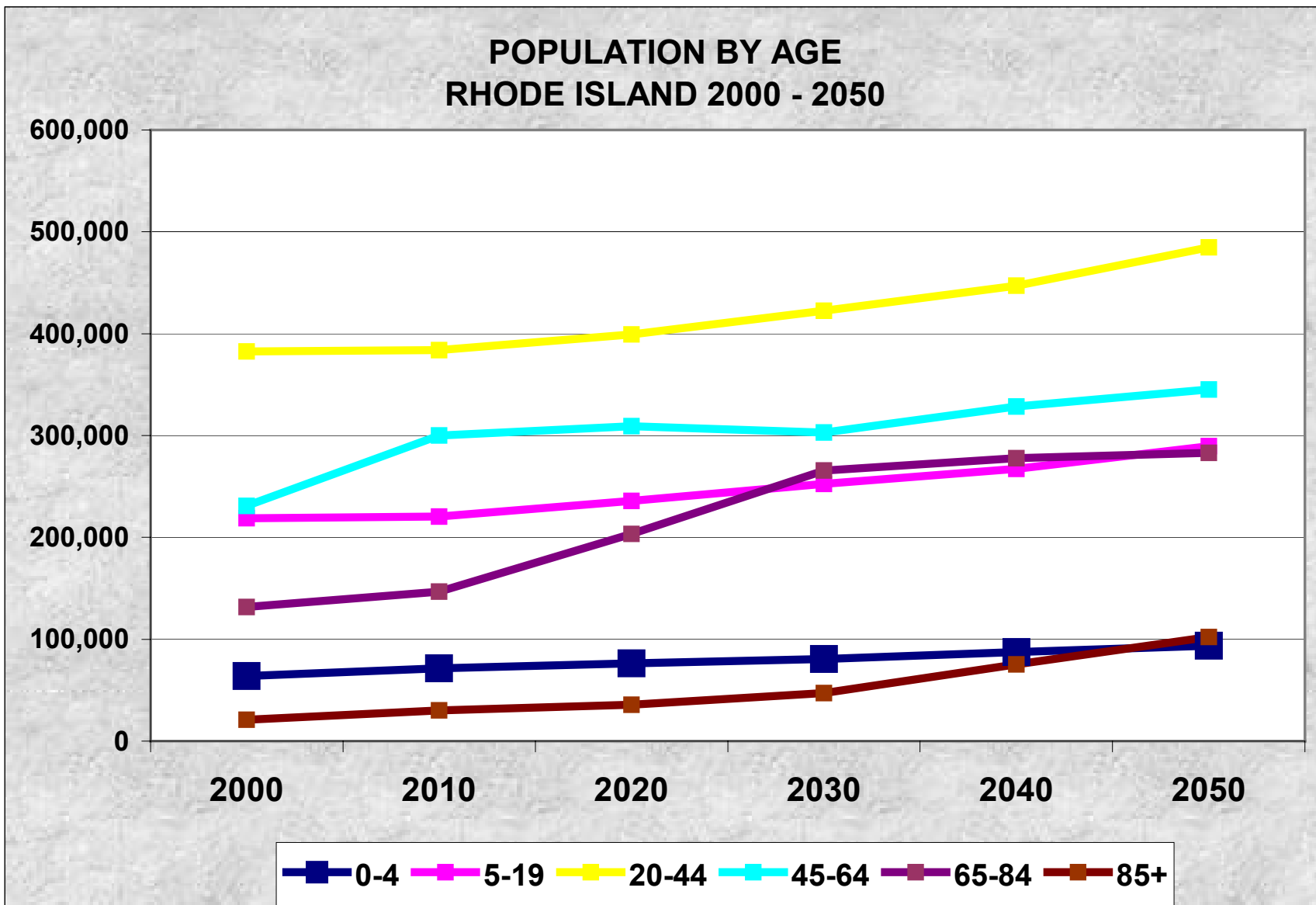
RACIAL & ETHNIC POPULATION GROWTH 2050

### WHITE AND NONWHITE POPULATIONS RHODE ISLAND 1970 - 2030



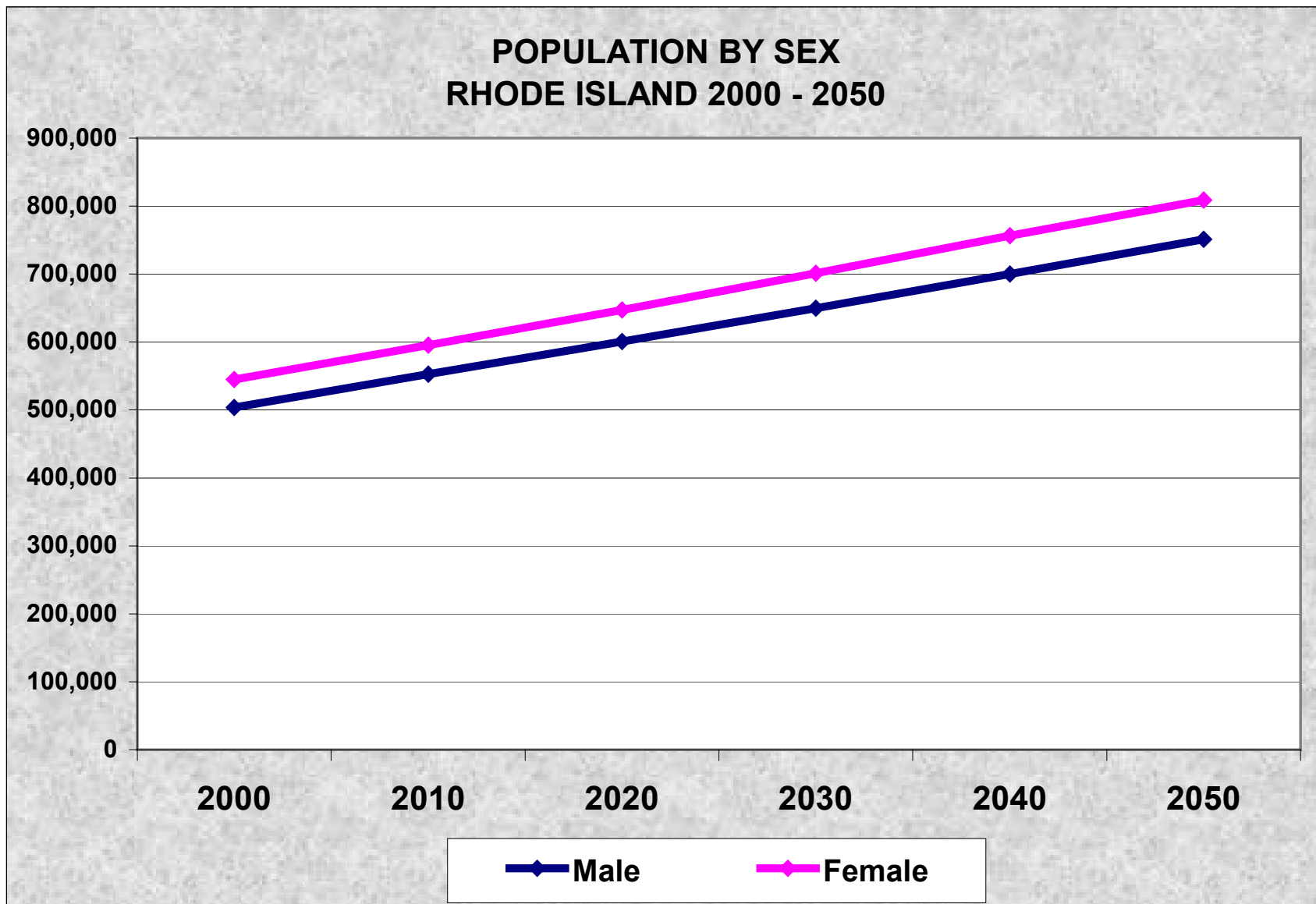
