CONSULTANT SUPPORT  
**COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT**

This Cooperative Agreement is entered into between the RHODE ISLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (RIDOT) and the RHODE ISLAND STATEWIDE PLANNING PROGRAM (Statewide Planning) for the purpose of funding transportation air quality consultant services.

*Whereas*, Statewide Planning has engaged a consultant to provide technical support for the State's Transportation Planning activities as documented in the attached Air Quality/Transportation Services Contract / Scope of Work.

*Whereas*, the services provided by the engaged consultant allow the State to remain in conformance with the Federal Clear Air Act and further enable the Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) to comply with rules and regulations of the Federal Highway Administration allowing the State to remain eligible for the receipt of Federal Transportation Funding.


*Whereas*, the Statewide Planning Program engaged the consultant with the understanding that RIDOT would contribute to the cost of the contract; however, the funding sharing arrangement had not been formalized.

*Now therefore*, the parties agree to the following terms:

1. This agreement covers the sharing of payments for services specified in the attached Scope of Work covering January 1, 2009 to June 30, 2014.
2. Statewide Planning shall pay the consultant for the services provided under the Scope of Work, and RIDOT shall, from its State funds, reimburse Statewide Planning 20 percent of the cost of the payments made to the consultant for the services provided. It is understood that RIDOT payments will be used to match Federal Funds allocated to Statewide Planning.
3. To obtain payment, Statewide Planning will submit an invoice to RIDOT with appropriate supporting documentation. RIDOT will make payment by fund transfer to the RIFANS account 10.068.1180101.05 (2477-9030).
4. The total amount of RIDOT payments under this agreement shall not exceed \$68,608.40.
5. This Agreement may be amended and extended by mutual agreement of the parties to it.
