In 2017, a new provision was added to RIGL §45-22-7 that requires that each member of a planning board or commission must participate in training and education classes concerning the effect of development in a flood plain and the effects of sea-level rise once every two years. Each member must complete two hours of training.

This brownbag workshop is offered to local officials involved in the planning and land management process to provide a common understanding of the state law amendments and to enable officials to be able to advise local planning boards and commissions accordingly.
