RE: Transmittal of Administrative Adjustment - Amendment 1 - to the State Transportation Improvement Program, FFY 2018-2027

Dear Mr. Machado and Ms. Mello:

The Secretary of the State Planning Council, the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the State of Rhode Island, approved an Administrative Adjustment, classified as Amendment #1, to the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for federal fiscal years 2018-2027, on March 15, 2018.

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) requested that a total increase of \$3.43 million in new funding be applied to the FFY 2018-2027 STIP. The increased funds comprise \$1.5 million from the City of Providence, which will be applied to FFY 2019 as a Third Party funding source. In addition, \$1.93 million in prior year Earmark funding will be distributed evenly across FFY 2018-2020 as Other Federal Non-Formula Distribution/Redistribution source for the Taunton Avenue/Warren Avenue on-ramp development project. There is also a shift of \$1.08 million in Traffic Safety funds to the Bridge Capital program. The new funding sources as well as the transfer of Traffic Safety funds are to be used for projects in the STIP categories of Bridge Capital and Pavement Capital.

In addition to the changes requested by RIDOT, the Division of Planning corrected project values in the STIP database and eliminated an instance in which funding was duplicated across projects. This change was identified in the STIP category of Traffic Safety.

I hereby concur with this amendment and provide my assurance that the STIP and this amendment satisfy all requirements of state and federal laws and regulations. I request that you provide the appropriate approvals and certifications so that these critical transportation projects may proceed.

Subject: **Request for Administrative Adjustments in the FFY2018-FFY2027 TIP**

Attached please find a file with all of the data collected for a requested Administrative Adjustment to the FFY2018-FFY2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The file includes all requested changes, with detailed notes: please don't hesitate to ask for clarification if there are any questions.

Any questions that you ask will help us to refine the forms that we use at RIDOT to collect Administrative Adjustment information. As discussed, it is our intent to submit one Administrative Adjustment on a quarterly basis, in February, May, August, and November. There will be no shifting between programs unless the change involves consolidation or efficiencies for projects taking place in the same geographic area. There will be additional funding only when a grant is received, outside funding is leveraged, or a project from a prior TIP with obligated earmark funding is brought back to the active list of projects.

As we move forward, for any amendments, we will submit the request with the signature of the Director and/or COO. For Administrative Adjustments, those will be processed through the Planning Division. I would suggest that distinction apply when we contemplate changes to the amendment structure.

First and foremost, our FFY2018-FFY2027 TIP remains fiscally constrained. There are 21 lines of changes, most in Bridge Groups (see spreadsheets in same book for details), and several related to the same change but impossible to show on one line.

There is a total increase of \$3.43 million, which comes from 1) \$1.5 million from City of Providence (should be shown as Third-Party Funding, State source) and 2) \$1.93 million in prior year Earmark funding (should be shown as Other Federal Non-Formula Distribution/Redis., a Federal source).

The only changes to the bottom lines of programs are:

- **Bridge** - \$1.5m more from local sources in Bridge; \$1.08m with \$1.0m in Other Federal and \$0.08m in HSIP funding shifted to Bridge from Traffic Safety to merge a Traffic Safety project with an ongoing bridge project and achieve efficiency.
- **Pavement** - \$1.93m to Pavement in prior year Earmark for Taunton/Warren Avenue Onramp development, spread over three years (FFY2018-FFY2020)
- **Traffic Safety**: \$1.08m less for shift to Bridge project.

Please see the attached page for some additional detail regarding the shifts.

Please review and grant administrative approval to the adjustment, with notice provided to appropriate parties (State Planning Council, TAC, FHWA) once it is complete.

Thank you for your assistance in this matter: we're happy to send staff over to walk through the changes with Statewide Planning staff at your convenience next week.

The Rhode Island Department of Administration, Division of Planning has received the Rhode Island Department of Transportation's (RIDOT) request of February 23, 2018 – Amended with Traffic Safety Source on March 5, 2018 for an Administrative Adjustment to the FFY2018-2027 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). Specifically, RIDOT requests that a total increase of \$3.43 million in new funding be applied to the FFY 2018-2027 STIP. The increased funds comprise \$1.5 million from the City of Providence, which will be applied to FFY 2019 as a Third Party funding source. In addition, \$1.93 million in prior year Earmark funding will be distributed evenly across FFY 2018-2020 as Other Federal Non Formula Distribution/Redistribution source for the Taunton Avenue/Warren Avenue on-ramp development project. There is also a shift of \$1.08 million in Traffic Safety funds to the Bridge Capital program. The new funding sources as well as the transfer of Traffic Safety funds are to be used for projects in the categories of Bridge Capital and Pavement Capital.

In addition to the changes requested by RIDOT, the Division of Planning corrected project values in the STIP database and eliminated an instance in which funding was duplicated across projects. This change was identified in the STIP category of Traffic Safety.

I have reviewed RIDOT's request against the 2003 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding procedures to amend and modify the STIP. As Secretary of the State Planning Council, I find that this request constitutes an Administrative Adjustment under the MOU and is hereby approved. The documentation submitted indicates that fiscal constraint of the STIP will be maintained.

For record keeping purposes, please note that this Administrative Adjustment shall be referred to as approved Amendment #1 to the FFY2018-2027 STIP. Revised STIP tables incorporating the modifications, dated March 15, 2018 are enclosed.
