

Mr. Flynn:

I am pleased to submit the enclosed on behalf of the Town of East Greenwich for inclusion in the State's FFY 2013-16 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). You will note that in comparing our submission to the current TIP, our priorities have not shifted and the importance of certain incomplete or unimplemented projects from prior programs is reiterated here. Our top priority continues to be completion of the East Greenwich Bicycle Network including the bridge connection between Crompton Avenue and Forge Road. Our second priority, as noted in the prior TIP, is Division Street Improvements in the vicinity of Route 2. Related improvements are currently underway but the plan specifically calls in the future for construction of a roundabout at the entrance to the New England Institute of Technology campus and the Town is anxious to see this project complete. Rounding out our top three priorities is a project which has already been prioritized by the State but it remains extremely important to the Town of East Greenwich. That project is the much-needed Route 4/I-95 interchange project which is in the design and assessment phase now.

I strongly urge the TAC to give full consideration to these projects as they stand to make a dramatic improvement to our Town's overall transportation network. Should you have any questions, please call.
