

Transportation Improvement plan 2018-2027: Submission Narrative

Several high priority projects submitted by the Rhode Island Bicycle Coalition in 2016 have been funded and are complete or near completion. We worked closely with our partners to assemble that list, and worked hard to support the priorities of the Woonasquatucket River Watershed Council, Bike Newport, the Paths to Progress Coalition, and the East Coast Greenway Alliance, as well as those of our municipal partners.

This year we looked at those projects still remaining and new projects that municipalities are planning on submitting to the STIP this year and prioritized them with our submissions from last year. Projects (both new and existing) were ranked based on their best chance for linking or paralleling heavy commuting areas and/or creating new connections between city neighborhoods with key employment and commercial areas.

Traffic and commuting times continue to increase. Local municipalities recognize that Transportation Alternatives are key to improving transportation in our communities and are submitting additional bike projects for consideration in the STIP.

It is our hope that the TAC will take these statewide bicycle infrastructure priorities to heart, and that even more funds from the TIP be allocated to Transportation Alternatives. All of these priorities, high, medium, and low, are important projects for connecting our statewide bicycle network and providing equitable access to active transportation. Even with the additional funding through RhodeWorks and the Green Economy Bond, there are not enough funds to complete all of these projects by when we need them. We continue to encourage RIDOT to search for additional sources of funding for bicycle infrastructure and are eager to help with that search.
